Consultation Interpretation Service

Interpretation service is available for the multicultural community during pharmacy consultation. It facilitates the communication between the patients with MC background and the pharmacist.



Train-the-Trainer (TTT) Training

30 hours of “Community Pharmacy Multicultural Trainees” training will be organised to assist the delivery of pharmacy services to the multicultural community. Job opportunities will be offered to the qualified trainees.

Health Condition Communication Tools

Communication tools will be developed and published to enhance the communication between the multicultural community and healthcare professionals.



Translated Health Educational Materials

Translated materials on medication-related knowledge will be developed and shared to the community to improve the overall health literacy of the multi-cultural community.

Health Promotional Booths

Outreach booths will be organised in the community for engaging and promoting community pharmacy service to raise the health awareness in the multicultural community.
