




Our pharmacists provide individual consultation services for the eligible groups* The scope of the consultation includes:

- >>> Assessment of medications, including their indications, side effects and potential interactions
- >>> Medication reconciliation, from which we create a personalised drug list
- >>> Development of an individualised health and medication management plan

- >>> Taking **5 or more** long-term medications,
- >> Taking high-risk medications, such as blood thinners or drugs for diabetes, mood or nervous diseases, and/or
- >> Having drug treatment **changed recently**, including recent hospital admissions and discharges, or starting new medications





Minor Ailment Management Service

When you have any symptoms, you can seek help from our pharmacy. After an initial assessment by the pharmacist, she or he will:

- >>> Suggest you use over-the-counter medications*
- >>> Provide health-care advice
- >>> Refer you to the doctor if needed

*Common conditions that can be managed by using over-the-counter medications include, but are not limited to: Dyspepsia, Heartburn. Flatulence, Constipation, and Diarrhoea

Community Health Education Activities

A series of medications and community health education-related activities, including talks and exhibitions, are planned. The public is frequently reached with health-related messages and information via our social media. These activities raise public awareness of medication use and strengthen their self-care abilities.

We wish to collaborate with other social organisations and develop primary care networks: therefore, community pharmacy can play a more important role in promoting primary care.
