- Educate clients, family members, and the community on how to prevent injuries and live a healthy lifestyle.
- Deliver health enhancement programmes and fitness programmes to clients, NGO partners and other collaborating parties.
- Strengthen the role of community physiotherapist in the transdisciplinary setting adopting a holistic care approach
- Take up/ assist in programme planning and evaluation related to community physiotherapy services
- Undertake any other duties as assigned by HIA
