Key responsibilities:

- Lead a nurse team to coordinate and perform healthcare management to service users in Hub and outreach services in the community including health assessment, care plan, case management, and home visit
- Design and execute community resilience and enabling programmes with transdisciplinary team members with social, medical, and allied health professional backgrounds
- Collaborate with the transdisciplinary team / external parties to develop and conduct health promotion and education workshops/programmes and provide related staff/volunteer training
- Assist the Executive Director and the Head of Services in coordinating, monitoring, and evaluating transdisciplinary approaches in clinical operations and case management, including data management and analysis, and inform the transdisciplinary team of the health status and progress of the cases
- Prepare reports for service monitoring and learning
- Stay abreast of the latest research, health trends, and protocols of the Hospital Authority, and apply them to the project, as appropriate.
- Consolidate practice knowledge related to community health service and transdisciplinary collaboration for knowledge management and dissemination.
- Undertake other duties as assigned by HIA

Requirements:

- Registered Nurse practicing certificate issued by the Nursing Council of Hong Kong. Degree in Nursing or equivalent
- Minimum 5 years of relevant working experience
- Experience in community health projects/ Primary Health Care/ Diabetes mellitus care/ Cardiology are advantages
- 5-day work, 1-2 night shifts until 9 pm on weekdays per week, 1-2 shift duties on weekend per month are required

- Ability to build and maintain rapport with clients
- Well-versed in common computer applications such as MS Office, Canva, Adobe Cloud, etc.
- Strong self-initiative, flexible, passionate in community engagement, and reliable with good interpersonal skills
- Open to work in a diverse and multicultural environment
- Excellent in spoken and written Chinese and English
