Healthy Compassionate Community is a two-year project that leverages the Asset-based Community Development (ABCD) approach to enhance community health in Kwong Fai Circuit. The initiative focuses on identifying and incubating key community stakeholders, transforming them into valuable community assets. By fostering connections among these stakeholders, the project aims to promote health through a variety of group programs, engaging community activities and targeted health campaigns.

Additionally, Health In Action's transdisciplinary team, along with dedicated volunteers, will operate street booth services to provide accessible health information and resources directly to the community. This comprehensive strategy not only empowers residents but also strengthens community ties, fostering a collaborative environment that prioritizes health and well-being.

Key Responsibilities:

- Oversee program operations for target groups, organizing volunteers and partners to execute community activities, services, and campaigns.
- Connect Health In Action with various community stakeholders to build networks and partnerships.
- Liaise with external partners, including NGOs and community groups, to organize healthy lifestyle programs.
- Assist in coordinating Health In Action's service support and operations, ensuring proper execution of administrative and operational procedures.
- Support the Project Manager in monitoring project objectives, outputs, and outcomes, and compile statistics for project reporting.
